

REGULATIONS OF THE KALISZANY DIVING BASE

(valid from 1 January 2017)

1. The KALISZANY DIVING BASE, here in after referred to as the base, is a private area monitored by the Hunters Security Agency.
2. It is possible to enter the base on foot or by car, and to stay in the base, only after paying the entry fee.
3. The base is open from May to September, on Saturdays and Sundays, from 10.00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. It is possible to use the base on remaining days of the week, after you call in advance. It is prohibited to stay in the base outside of the designated hours.
4. The services offered by the base, such as: filling of diving cylinders, DLD – Discover Local Diving, lease of equipment and others, are subject to additional fees, as per the price list.
5. Some of the services offered by the base, e.g. night diving, require phone or email contact in advance.
6. The persons diving in the base need to enter their names in the so-called base diving log and, after diving, they need to sign to confirm that they left the water.
7. Making an entry in the base diving log is tantamount to confirming that you are familiar with the regulations and that you accept them.
8. The diver takes full responsibility for all of its dives.
9. The training or traineeship dives are organized and secured (oxygen and equipment for oxygenation) by the lead instructor.
10. The persons conducting or supervising training or traineeship dives must possess valid obligatory civil liability insurance, e.g. with DAN.
11. The recreational dives are organized by the person with the highest diving certification.
12. The owners of the diving base and the service personnel do not assume responsibility for the items left in the base by the clients.
13. Animals are welcome, but their owners bear full responsibility for their behavior.
14. In the area of the base and of the underwater route, it is prohibited to conduct underwater fishing.
15. In the area of the base, it is prohibited to bring or consume alcohol or intoxicating agents.
16. The persons using the equipment of the base or the diving route, are fully liable for damage there to or destruction thereof.
